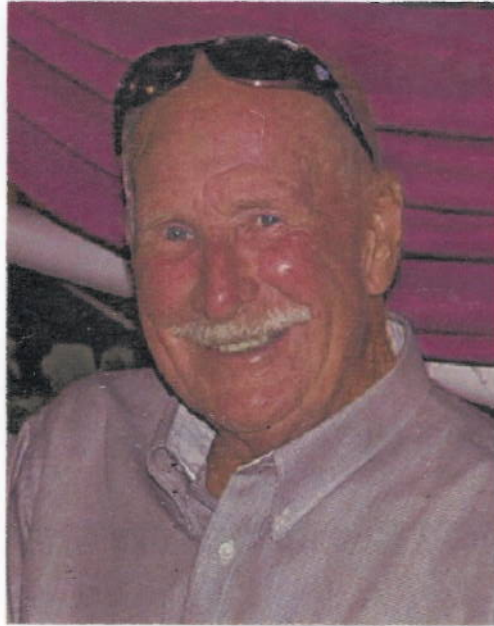


Brian Richard Bell
